

**GREATER VANCOUVER SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE DISTRICT**  
**BYLAW NO. 391, 2025**  
**A bylaw to amend Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District**  
**Trucked Liquid Waste Bylaw No. 345, 2021**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. The *Environmental Management Act*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 53 and the *Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District Act*, S.B.C. 1956, c. 59 authorize the Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District (the “District”) Board (the “Board”) to make bylaws respecting the direct or indirect discharge of wastes into any sewer or drain connected to a sewage facility operated by the District;
- B. The Board wishes to amend the “Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District Trucked Liquid Waste Bylaw No. 345, 2021”.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Board of the Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District enacts as follows:

**Citation**

1. The official citation of this bylaw is “Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District Trucked Liquid Waste Amendment Bylaw No. 391, 2025”.

**Effective Date**

2. This bylaw will come into effect on January 1, 2026.

**Schedule**

3. The following Schedule is attached to and forms part of the bylaw:
  - Schedule “A”, Trucked Liquid Waste Discharge Fees.

**Amendment of Bylaw**

4. “Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District Trucked Liquid Waste Bylaw No. 345, 2021” is amended as follows:


- (a) Schedule “A” is deleted and replaced with Schedule “A”, Trucked Liquid Waste Discharge Fees, which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.
- (b) A new section is added after section 15, as follows:

15.1 *Trucked liquid waste* must not be discharged for treatment at the Northwest Langley Wastewater Treatment Plant’s *sewage facility*, except if:

- (a) it is *domestic waste* that was generated within the Township of Langley and collected by that generator in a *holding tank* within the Township of Langley, or
- (b) the *Sewage Control Manager* has provided a written approval for the discharge, at that *sewage facility*, of *domestic trucked liquid waste* that was generated outside the Township of Langley.

Read a first, second, and third time this 31<sup>st</sup> day of OCTOBER, 2025.

Adopted this 31<sup>st</sup> day of OCTOBER, 2025.

## Schedule A

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### TRUCKED LIQUID WASTE DISCHARGE FEES

1. Effective January 1, 2026, the *discharge fee* applicable to a discharge of *trucked liquid waste* is calculated in accordance with the discharge fee rates set out in Table 1 for *in-region generated waste* and *out-of-region generated waste* respectively.

Table 1: Trucked Liquid Waste Discharge Fees (\$/m<sup>3</sup>)

Discharge Fee Type		Discharge Fee Rate (\$/m <sup>3</sup> )
<i>in-region generated waste</i>	<i>domestic trucked liquid waste</i>	\$72
	<i>non-domestic trucked liquid waste</i>	\$117
<i>out-of-region generated waste</i> (valid <i>out-of-region discharge number</i> required)	<i>domestic trucked liquid waste</i>	\$90
	<i>non-domestic trucked liquid waste</i>	\$144
