Electoral Area A Clean-up Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1433, 2026 — Assent Voting (Referendum)

On Saturday, October 17, 2026, Metro Vancouver will hold an assent vote and is seeking applications from residents to act as scrutineers.

Assent Voting Question

Are you in favour of the Metro Vancouver Regional District adopting MVRD Bylaw No. 1433, 2026 to establish within portions of Electoral Area A, a service for the purpose of the coordination, transportation, and disposal of waste items generated from water-access properties within the area, and to authorize a maximum annual taxation of \$20,000 or \$0.6/\$1,000 of net taxable value of improvements, whichever is greater?

Scrutineer Opportunity

Scrutineers play an important role in observing the voting process and helping ensure its integrity, transparency, and fairness. This opportunity is available only to individuals who are eligible to vote in the assent vote.
