

# **NOTICE RESPECTING ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW**

*Under sections 464(2) and 467 of the Local Government Act*

**FRIDAY, February 27, 2026 at 9:00 am**

**Meeting to be held in 28th Floor Boardroom  
4515 Central Boulevard, Burnaby, British Columbia**

**Metro Vancouver Regional District Electoral Area A  
Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1446, 2026**

Metro Vancouver Regional District ("Metro Vancouver") proposes to amend *Greater Vancouver Regional District Electoral Area A Zoning Bylaw No. 1144, 2011* to enable the issuance of temporary use permits that:

- allow a use not permitted by a zoning bylaw;
- specify conditions under which the temporary use may be carried on; and
- allow and regulate the construction of buildings or structures in respect of the use for which the permit is issued.

The area to which the bylaw applies is land within Electoral Area A, excluding UBC, the University Endowment Lands (UEL), Bowyer Island, and Passage Island.

The rezoning application is consistent with the *Electoral Area A Official Community Plan*. Per section 464(2) of the *Local Government Act*, a Public Hearing is not required for Metro Vancouver Regional District Electoral Area A Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1446, 2026. Notice is provided per section 467 of the *Local Government Act*.
