### DIRECTION FROM THE METRO VANCOUVER BOARD

Expedite Move to having Growth Pay for Growth

| Metro Vancouver Service            | Current State                     | Future Plan                    |
|------------------------------------|-----------------------------------|--------------------------------|
| Water Services                     | 50% Assist Factor with Interest   | 1% Assist Factor with Interest |
| Liquid Waste Services              | 17.5% Assist Factor with Interest | 1% Assist Factor with Interest |
| Regional Parks Land<br>Acquisition | No DCCs                           | 1% Assist Factor with Interest |



### RESEARCH ON MUNICIPAL DCCs

Consultants conducted a regional and Canada-wide survey of how DCCs are used by municipalities:

- Services provided that use DCCs
- Bylaw updates
- Application of charges area specific vs municipal-wide
- Discretionary Exemptions
- DCC amounts charged



### **OBSERVATIONS**

- Metro Vancouver and local municipalities developed DCCs in isolation of one another
- Inconsistency with respect to:
  - Structure and size of the charge
  - Timing of DCC bylaw updates
- Consistency with respect to:
  - Services provided in DCC by-laws
  - Discretionary exemptions (minimal)


### **LOOKING AHEAD**

Following recent Board direction, Metro Vancouver's next steps include:

- Examine other development types, e.g. multi-family, industrial/commercial
- Understand the economic impact of DCCs on the region
- Initiate the process to develop a DCC for Regional Parks
- Align the DCC update process for MV DCC's to simplify application and collection by member jurisdictions
