

## **Engine Registration & Fees**

- Increased registration fees for Tier 0 and Tier 1 engines starting 2024.
- New engine registration and labelling requirements for:
  - ° Tier 2 starting January 1, 2023
  - ° Tier 3 starting January 1, 2024
  - ° Tier 4 starting January 1, 2029
- New moderate-use operating period category starting January 1, 2024
  - ° 60% annual fees to operate 500 hours
- Options for Prohibited Tier 0 & Tier 1 engines to register starting in 2023
  - ° Pay 300% operating fee surcharge, or
  - ° Install an approved Emission Reduction Measure to achieve Tier 2 or better emissions.

### **Retirement Rebates**

• Starting in 2026 the retirement rebate will be 80% of fees paid in the last 5 years (increased from 3 years).

### Sensitive Receptor Requirements

• Effective immediately, Tier 0 and Tier 1 engines cannot be operated within 100 meters of sensitive receptors (i.e. schools, hospitals, daycares).

### **Emergency Generators**

 New requirements for emergency engines to be operated, inspected, and maintained to prevent impacts on nearby building occupants.



# Attention Diesel Engine owner and operators: What do you need to do?

Continue to register, label, and purchase operating periods for your current **Tier 0** and **Tier 1** non-road diesel engines.

Prepare for future engine registration: Collect machine and engine details of your non-road diesel engine fleet. Use the following charts to determine engine tier and applicable registration fees.
