Project Overview

Metro Vancouver is completing improvements to the Iona Island Causeway to provide safer access to Iona Island for all road users and to better support construction needs during future phases of the Iona Projects.

Work Will Include

- Road improvements, including widening the travel lanes, adding a construction vehicle queue lane and cycling shoulders on both sides of the road
- Upgrades to underground utilities to support the wastewater treatment plant
- Planting a landscaped boulevard
- Construction of a greenway for pedestrians and recreational cycling

Hours of work

Monday to Friday between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm

Work hours may sometimes be extended to complete specific tasks and/or stay on schedule. All work will comply with City of Richmond bylaws or granted bylaw variances.

What to Expect During Construction

Metro Vancouver is committed to limiting impacts to road and park users during construction wherever possible.

- Public access to Iona Island will be maintained during construction.
- Signage and traffic control personnel will be on site to guide road and park users.
- There will be clearing, brushing, and tree removal within the work area along the roadway. A tree management plan is in place to retain as many trees as possible.

Construction impacts may include

- Traffic delays
- Noise and dust
- Single-lane alternating traffic
- Construction vehicles in the area
- Reduced access and parking on the causeway

Future Work

Due to the size and complexity of the Iona Projects, work in this area will be staggered. Shoreline restoration will be considered as part of future work.
