

Greater Vancouver Sewerage and Drainage District (GVS&DD) Tipping Fee Bylaw – Generator Levy Overview



Loads that only contain one of the above categories are **exempt** from the generator levy when delivered to facilities other than Metro Vancouver or City of Vancouver solid waste facilities

GENERATOR LEVY



Municipal solid waste (garbage) to **Metro Vancouver** or **City of Vancouver** solid waste facilities

Municipal solid waste (garbage) to facilities **other than** Metro Vancouver or City of Vancouver solid waste facilities



- Haulers **collect** fees from their customers (which includes the generator levy)
- Haulers **pay the tipping fee** (which includes the generator levy)



- Haulers **collect** fees from their customers (which includes the generator levy)
- Haulers **send** the generator levy to the GVS&DD quarterly

Hauler responsibilities under the Tipping Fee Bylaw include:


- Collect the generator levy from their customers within the GVS&DD
- Send the generator levy to the GVS&DD (through paying tipping fees or by sending a separate payment)
- Keep and maintain records
- Provide the GVS&DD with access to inspect and copy records when requested

If a hauler disposes of municipal solid waste (garbage) at a Metro Vancouver or City of Vancouver solid waste facility, no further action is required for paying the levy for those loads because the generator levy is included in the tipping fee at those facilities. You will still need to meet all other requirements of the Tipping Fee Bylaw, including keeping and maintaining records in an electronic format.

If a hauler disposes of municipal solid waste (garbage) at a facility other than a Metro Vancouver or City of Vancouver solid waste facility, then the hauler is required to send the generator levy amount for those loads to the GVS&DD each quarter.

In the event of any inconsistency between the information in this document and the Tipping Fee Bylaw, the Tipping Fee Bylaw will prevail.
