

# 2026 Garbage and Recycling Fees

## Starting July 1, 2026

The table below outlines changes in garbage and recycling fees starting July 1, 2026, at Metro Vancouver solid waste facilities.

Garbage tipping fees will increase by \$2 per tonne for loads 1 tonne and over at all Metro Vancouver solid waste facilities. There is no rate change for garbage loads under 1 tonne. The fees for yard trimmings and clean wood will increase to \$139 per tonne (from \$124). The fee for municipal organics will increase to \$155 per tonne (from \$117). The fee for mixed organics will increase to \$175 per tonne (from \$150).

<b>Garbage: 1 – 7.99 tonnes</b>	<b>\$162/tonne</b> , up to a maximum of <b>\$1,093</b> per load
<b>Garbage: 8 tonnes or more</b>	<b>\$136/tonne</b>
Garbage: Municipal	\$148/tonne
Construction and demolition processing residual waste	\$194/tonne
Transaction fee*	\$5 per load
Peak hours (10:00 am – 2:00 pm weekdays)**	\$25 minimum per load
Non-Peak Hours	\$15 minimum per load
Special handle waste	\$310/tonne, with a minimum of \$55 per load
<b>Municipal organics</b>	<b>\$155/tonne</b> , with a minimum of \$10 per load
Used gypsum	\$210/tonne, with a minimum of \$15 per load
New gypsum	\$158/tonne, with a minimum of \$15 per load
<b>Yard trimmings / Clean wood</b>	<b>\$139/tonne</b> , with a minimum of \$10 per load
<b>Mixed organics***</b>	<b>\$175/tonne</b> , with a minimum of \$10 per load
Mattresses / Box springs	\$20 each, maximum 4 units
Weight only	\$15/ticket

\* Applies to each load of solid waste or gypsum delivered to a solid waste facility

\*\*Excludes Statutory Holidays and is not applicable at Central Surrey, Langley, and Maple Ridge recycling and waste centres and the Waste-to-Energy Facility

\*\*\*Mixed organics are accepted up to 100 kg per load, with the exception of the North Shore Recycling and Waste Centre which accepts quantities greater than 100 kg per load

- Fees include the generator levy and disposal rate where applicable

- Minimum and maximum fees include the transaction fee where applicable
