

TARGETS VS METRICS

- Primary Metrics
 - High level indicators to demonstrate overall plan progress
- Targets:
 - Numerical objectives applied to primary targets
- Secondary Metrics:
 - Quantitative or qualitative indicators to support progress measurement in specific areas



IDENTIFYING PRIMARY METRICS AND TARGETS

- Informed by Stantec Performance Metrics report and committee feedback
- Represent progress across all levels of hierarchy
- Builds upon existing baseline data
- Ambitious but achievable targets







DRAFT 2050 TARGETS

2025 Baseline



20% Reduction in Waste Generation Per Capita by 2050
(10% by 2040)

80% Diversion/75 % Recycling by 2050
(75%/70% by 2040)




50% Reduction in Disposal Per Capita by 2050
(30% by 2040)

Carbon Neutral by 2050
(45% reduction by 2030)




SECONDARY METRICS

- Suite of metrics that provide additional context beyond high level targets
- Help demonstrate progress in specific areas
- Informed by Stantec's research and analysis



SECONDARY METRICS



SECONDARY METRICS

R	Goal	Example Secondary Metrics
Rethink	Enable circular systems that preserve resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• awareness of circular economy (survey)• # of circular jobs• # of circular initiatives or education supported/introduced
Reduce	Minimize waste generation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• # of single-use items in waste stream• tonnes food loss and waste• increased waste prevention habits (survey)
Reuse	Keep resources in use as long as possible	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• tonnes measurable reuse• # items repaired at repair events• # of homes relocated• tonnes food rescued• reuse behaviours (survey)


SECONDARY METRICS

Examples

R	Goal	Potential Secondary Metrics
Recycle	Make it easier to recycle effectively	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recycling rate by sector• Recycling rate by material category• Trust/confidence in recycling programs (survey)
Recover	Recover resources from non-recyclable materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tonnes recovered• % of diversion that is recovery• GHG reduction from alternative fuels
Dispose	Dispose only as a last resort	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Energy generated (waste-to-energy and landfill)• Remaining landfill capacity• GHG from disposal facilities

NEXT STEPS

- Feedback will be considered in updating targets and metrics, which will be incorporated into the draft plan
- Draft plan to be presented and distributed in early 2026


