Lawn watering*		 No watering
Watering trees, shrubs, inedible flowers/plants		 Water manually any day at any time (use hand-held hose with shut-off device, soaker hose, water container, or drip irrigation)  Water with sprinkler any day 5:00 am to 9:00 am
Vegetable gardens		 Can be watered at any time
Decorative water features (fountains, ponds)		 No topping up or filling
Washing cars and boats		
At home		 Washing allowed (includes hand-held hose with shut-off device)
At a commercial car wash		 Washing allowed
Washing impermeable surfaces		
Personal pressure washer and garden hoses		 Washing for health or safety reasons, preparing a surface for painting or similar treatment  No aesthetic cleaning
Hired commercial cleaner		 All types of cleaning activities are allowed
Pools and hot tubs		
Personal		 No impact
Public**		 Remain open
Spray parks		 User-activated spray parks remain open

* Public spaces like sports fields and golf courses have separate water restrictions.
