

# Which distances apply to you?

## 1 Burn Pile



### Requirements

- 1 burn pile max. 2 m high by 3 m wide
- Remove stumps and do not burn them
- Diameter of pieces must be less than 10 cm
- Complete the burning in 1 day

## For all open burns:

### Call 604-436-6777

Before you burn, call Metro Vancouver

- for the burning conditions that day\*
- to notify that you intend to burn

### Explore Alternatives

Consider chipping, grinding, shredding, and beneficial reuse like composting or mulching

### Keep Records

Consider an OBER Record Form to retain pertinent details about each burn

### Maximum Burn Days

(or portions of days)

- 12 in a calendar year
- 6 in a calendar month

\*Air Curtain Incinerator use allows for increased opportunities to burn

## 2 Burn Piles



### Requirements

- 2 burn piles, each max. 2 m high by 3 m wide
- Burning stumps is allowed
- Complete the burning in 2 days

Smaller distances apply if burning diseased vegetative debris, under a plan for community wildfire risk reduction or for flood management & flood emergencies.

Methods to determine the distance from the burn pile include: using a measuring tape and online measuring tools (ex. Google Maps).
